



Multiple Rainouts/Holidays/Sub Rules

SPIRIT OF THE GAME

COMPETITIVE PLAY IS IMPORTANT, BUT NEVER AT THE EXPENSE OF FOLLOWING THE RULES, RESPECTING OTHER PLAYERS, RESPECTING THE BAR/FACILITY, AND HAVING FUN!

General Rule:

- Substitute players are not allowed in playoff games. Only players listed on the official team roster are eligible to participate in playoff matches.

Playoff Schedule:

- The league will provide a schedule for the playoffs well in advance, including the dates of the playoff games.
- In the event that a playoff game falls on a recognized holiday or after more than 2 rainouts, a special provision is made to consider the use of substitute players.
- The league and the teams involved must agree upon the use of substitute players for playoff games that fall under these parameters.

Agreement Process:

- Once the playoff dates are determined, given that they fall under the multiple rainout/holiday parameters, a note will be sent out to the league acknowledging the date and stating how there will be some flexibility with substitute players given the extenuating circumstances.
- Teams requesting substitute players for a rain delayed/holiday playoff game must submit a request to the league at least 4 days before playoffs.
- The team should provide names of which players on their roster cannot attend, and who they will be replaced with if allowed.

- Replacement players must have played with ASSC in past seasons or must sign waiver before they play
- Teams still need to meet the minimum requirements of 50% of their team available to play to avoid a forfeit. If this cannot be met, the team will forfeit and no subs will be allowed.
- League will review the proposed players and will talk with the captain on if they can allow them or not, or if there needs to be a compromise.
- Once an agreement has been made, the league will place the new players on the roster before playoffs.
